What Is It?

Cannabis has been legal since 2018 as a medicine, prescribed by a specialist doctor. Both **THC** and **CBD** are prescribed in many different formulations; **flower, oils, capsules, vape cartridges and more...**

For What Conditions?

There is **no limit** to what condition can be prescribed as long as there is a clinical need. There are only a few conditions that will not be considered for treatment.

What Will My Employer Say?

As long as your contract does not require you to disclose any medications that you use, you will only need to disclose your use if you require **reasonable adjustments**, which they must legally accommodate.

Can I Drive?

As long as you are not impaired you are legally entitled to drive whilst over the THC limit with your **prescribed cannabis medicine** in your system.

Where Can I Use It?

You can use your medication **where ever you need** to at your own discretion. Those using flower do not fall under the “no smoking/vaping” policies when using their medication as directed by their doctor.

How Do I Use It?

Depending on the formulation you are prescribed you can either use; Oils **under the tongue**, capsules **orally**, vape cartridges and cannabis flower via **inhalation**. Your specialist doctor will guide you through your treatment.
