PC - Feeling suicidal, medication issues

HPC - Background of having medical cannabis prescribed through a vapouriser, which he describes as being in form of 'cannabis flower', this is from a private clinic and private pharmacy

- He was visiting his sister saturday in plymouth and was in possession of his cannabis and taking using the vapouriser in public when police discovered this due to smelling the cannabis and went on to arrest him
- He states that he is not a criminal and was thrown to the ground and then taken to custody and had his cannabis taken from him
- The experience of this today has made him feel suicidal, he walked along a busy road which resulted in him being picked up by police and conveyed to Derriford for psych assessment
- He has not harmed himself in anyway but states he feels that what is the point in living when you get treated that way
- He was referred to first response who have told him he is able to b discharged home, however he feels that he would like to see PLNs
- Patient concerned that he now does not have his cannabis medication and won't be able to get it for a while
